Overview of role

The Plumbing and Heating Engineer is responsible for installing, repairing and maintaining Gas Heating system, alongside installing, repairing and maintaining pipes, fixtures and other heating and water distribution and waste water disposal in residential, commercial and industrial buildings.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

The work of a Plumbing and Heating Engineer is varied and can include the following:

- Carry out all stage of relevant gas/heating checks, from 1st (pre-installation); 2nd (flue extension); and 3rd (final completion).
- Review building plans and specifications to determine the layout for plumbing and heating systems
- Select the type and size of pipe required
- Locate and mark positions for connections and fixtures
- Install supports and hangers for pipe, fixtures and equipment
- Assemble and install valves and fittings
- Install, repair and maintain water treatment equipment, piping and controls
- Install, repair and maintain heating systems
- Install, repair and maintain plumbing fixtures, appliances and trim
- Install, repair and maintain gutters, downpipes, soil stacks and soil vent pipes.
- Test pipe systems and fixtures for leaks
- Ensure all requirements as specified by the manufacturer of systems and fixtures are met
- Install Medically adapted bathrooms such as wet floor and level access showers
- Working on Kitchen and bathroom replacement programs and working as part of a small organised team.
- To complete all required documentation accurately, on a regular basis and to specified deadlines
- To work as a team member alongside other trades, colleagues, partners and members of the public
- To ensure full compliance with all health and safety procedures and requirements of statutory legislation
