General Duties/Key Responsibilities:

The work of an Electrician is varied and can include the following:

- To install, repair, renew, test and maintain electrical installations as required, meeting all legislative requirements (mainly domestic).
- Inspect, test and issue certification for all electrical installations and repairs,
- Carry out fault diagnosis on site,
- Prepare sites for safe working,
- Keep up to date with required trade qualifications,
- Report all non-electrical faults to the Line Manager,
- Keep records of work undertaken, including maintenance & repairs work,
- Comply with H&S policies and procedures and carry out on site risk assessments for jobs undertaken,
- Attending training in support of position as instructed by management.
- Alterations and new circuits to domestic properties
- Installation of wiring for new showers and shower pumps
- Testing and inspection to fixed wiring circuit including filling in certificates
- Core out, wire and install ventilation fans.
